I, [REDACTED], hereby state and aver as follows:

1. I am of the age of majority, of sound mind and body, and base this affidavit upon my personal knowledge.

2. On November 9, 2003, I was shopping at Calphalon Warehouse in Northwood and on my way out of the warehouse, almost back to my car, I passed by and witnessed and observed the following:
 - a. A uniformed officer was speaking to a lady in a parked, blue Volvo.
 - b. The officer spoke loudly enough for me to hear him say, "do you think that this time, you could park your car between the cones."
 - c. Thus, he wanted her in front in my car and not beside it.
 - d. After he had spoken to her, he said, do you think you can move your car off my foot now.

- e. I could not see if the car was on her foot, but I thought it was unusual that her car had not moved and if she was on his foot, he would have asked her to move immediately.
- f. During the entire conversation with the officer and the lady parked in the blue Volvo, the Volvo car remained stationary the entire time.
- g. The officer then explained to the lady that "no, when you turned your wheel, you ran over my foot."
- h. However, the officer showed no reaction of pain or distress.
- i. I then went back into the store to pick up additional packages that I had purchased, and when I returned, I noticed the blue volvo parked in front of my car where the officer had asked her to park it.
- j. Curious, I looked around for the officer and saw him walking off with another man, possibly an employee or security guard of the store. Again, the police officer did not appear to be limping as he walked, which is perhaps unusual for someone who claims his foot to have been run over.
